Attached is a copy of the agenda as of this date. I am looking forward to seeing you there.

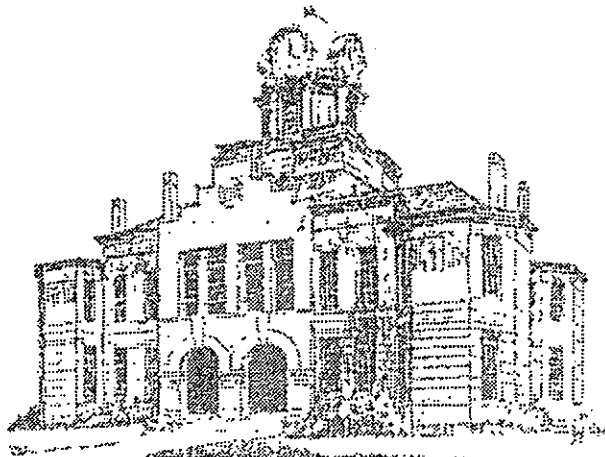

CUMBERLAND COUNTY COMMISSION MONTHLY MEETING

Be it remembered that the Cumberland County Commission met in monthly session on Monday, September 18, 2017 at the courthouse in Crossville, Tennessee. Sheriff Deputy Jerry Jackson called the meeting to order at 6:00 o'clock P.M. Present and presiding was Commission Chairman, County Mayor Kenneth Carey, Jr. who invited Minister Willard Dale from the Southwest Baptist Church to give the Invocation and members of the Young Marines lead the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag of the United States of America. Also present at the meeting were County Attorney Randal Boston, Finance Director Nathan Brock, Road Superintendent Scott Blaylock, Director of Schools Janet Graham and the following County Commissioners:

A quorum being present, the Cumberland County Commission was opened in due form of law and the following proceedings were had to wit:

1. MINUTES OF AUGUST 21, 2017 MONTHLY CUMBERLAND COUNTY COMMISSION MEETING:

On motion of Commissioner Claffin, second by Commissioner Gibson, moved the minutes of the August 21, 2017 Monthly Commission Meeting be approved, treat same as read, made a matter of record, and filed.

The motion to approve the meeting minutes carried by a roll vote of 14 ayes from the Commission present with Commissioners Hassler and Farley abstaining and Commissioner Rimmer passing on the vote.

COMMENTS:

The first to comment was Cliff Segar of 74 Alyson Lane, Rockwood, Tennessee who extended a special invitation to the Board to attend a public meeting in October to meet Ted Hartke, President of Hartke Engineering and Surveying, Inc. located in Ogden, Illinois, to hear his testimony about living near wind turbines and his experiences with wind farm operations. Next, Millstone Mountain resident Jim Martin presented each Commissioner with a copy of a book written by Gregg Hubner titled "Paradise Destroyed-The Destruction of Rural Living by the Wind Energy Scam". Mr. Martin encouraged everyone to take the time to read the book to learn more about industrial wind turbine developments and how government works in relation to alternative sources of energy.

2. UNFINISHED BUSINESS: RESOLUTION 08-2017-1-SETTING THE SPEED LIMIT ON A COUNTY ROAD (SAWMILL ROAD) LISTED ON THE OFFICIAL ROAD LIST OF CUMBERLAND COUNTY, TENNESSEE:

On motion of Commissioner Stone, second by Commissioner Foster, moved to adopt resolution 08-2017-1.

Before the vote, Commissioner Stone confirmed the appeal to set a speed limit on a county road went through the proper committee process and was supported by members of the Environmental Committee. The original petition signed by those Sawmill Road residents seeking a reduced speed limit was given to the County Clerk by Commissioner Stone to accompany the resolution.

The motion to adopt resolution 08-2017-1, setting the speed limit on Sawmill Road at thirty-five (35) miles per hour, directing the Highway Department to post suitable signs and instruct the Regional Planning Commission to document the speed limit on the Official Road List, carried by a roll call vote of 15 ayes from the Commission with Commissioner Rimmer passing on the vote. Commissioner Geisler voted against the adoption of resolution 08-2017-1 with Commission Carter absent.

3. ELECTION OF CHAIRMAN OF THE CUMBERLAND COUNTY COMMISSION:

Commissioner Hassler nominated County Mayor Kenneth Carey, Jr. to serve as Chairman of the Cumberland County Commission with Commissioner Hyder seconding the nomination.

There being no other nominee, Kenneth Carey, Jr. was elected to serve another one (1) year term as Chairman of the Cumberland County Board of Commissioners by a roll call vote of 17 ayes from the Commission present.

4. ELECTION OF CHAIRMAN PRO-TEM OF THE CUMBERLAND COUNTY COMMISSION:

Commissioner Allen Foster was nominated by Commissioner Hassler to serve as Chairman Pro-Tem of the Commission. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Isham.

Allen Foster was elected to serve a one (1) year term as Chairman Pro-Tem of the Cumberland County Board of Commissioners by a roll call vote of 16 ayes from the Commission present with Commissioner Foster passing on the vote.

5. CUMBERLAND COUNTY COMMISSION PARLIAMENTARIAN:

Commissioner Nancy Hyder was nominated by Commissioner Hassler to serve as Parliamentarian of the Cumberland County Commission. Commissioner Stone seconded the nomination.

Nancy Hyder was elected to serve another one (1) year term as Commission Parliamentarian by a roll call vote of 16 ayes from the Commission present with Commissioner Hyder passing on the vote.

6. RESOLUTION 09-2017-1-TO APPOINT TIM CLAFLIN, RICK WILLIAMS, JOSH STONE, JILL DAVIS AND VALERIE COX AS MEMBERS TO THE ETHICS COMMITTEE FOR ONE (1) YEAR TERMS TO EXPIRE SEPTEMBER 30, 2018:

On motion of Commissioner Foster, second by Commissioner Scarbrough, moved to adopt resolution 09-2017-1.

The motion to adopt resolution 09-2017-1, appointing Tim Claflin, Rick Williams, Josh Stone, Jill Davis and Valerie Cox to serve on the Ethics Committee for one (1) year terms to expire September 30, 2018, carried by a roll call vote of 16 ayes from the Commission present with Commissioner Claflin passing on the vote.

7. RESOLUTION 09-2017-2-TO REAPPOINT JOYCE RORABAUGH AS CUMBERLAND COUNTY ARCHIVIST FOR A TERM TO BEGIN OCTOBER 1, 2017 AND END SEPTEMBER 30, 2018:

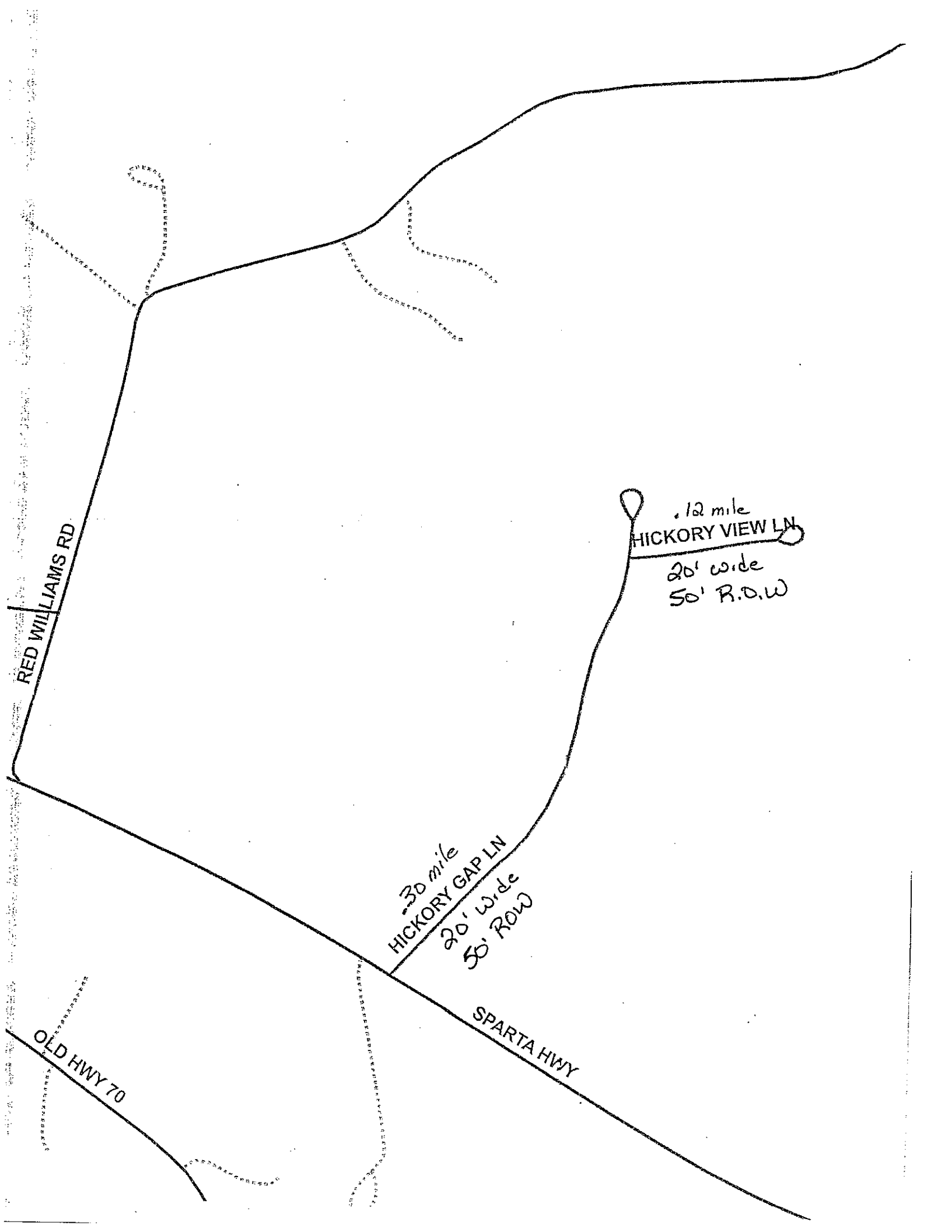

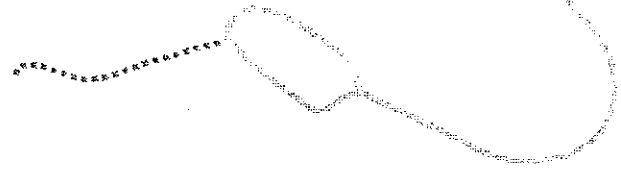
