This application must be signed under oath in the presence of a notary public and submitted to the County Clerk prior to the meeting of the county legislative body at which it is to be considered. The Cumberland County Commission Meeting is held the third (3rd) Monday of each month (you are not required to attend). No money or fees can be collected or paid until the County Commission has approved your application. Once elected, you must then be commissioned by the Governor. If elected, you will be required to post a bond in the amount of ten thousand dollars (\$10,000.00). The bond must be filed in the office of the County Clerk, who will accept the required fees and administer the oath of office. You are not authorized to act as a notary public until you have received your commission from the Governor, filed your bond, and taken the oath of office. If you move your residence or your principal place of business out of this county, you are required by law to notify the County Clerk of the change of address.
