\*\*\*Additional qualifying papers required as follows:

**Candidates for Sheriff** must file affidavit of qualifications and other evidence of their qualifications and standards required with the Tennessee Peace Officer Standards and Training Commission on or before February 6, 2014.

**Candidate for Road Superintendent** must file qualifications and other evidence of their qualifications and standards required with the Tennessee Highway Officials certification Board on or before February 6, 2014.

**QUALIFYING DEADLINE: FEBRUARY 20, 2014 AT 12:00 NOON**

Candidates shall file their original petition in the county election office where they reside and a certified duplicate petition in any county within their district by the qualifying deadline.

**All candidates** for the above listed offices have the same qualifying deadlines as Republican and Democratic Party candidates. T.C.S. 2-5.1010(a) “ Independent and primary candidates for any office to be filled in a regular August general election for which a May primary has been called under T.C.A 2-13-203 shall qualify by filing their petitions for the August election no later than twelve (12:00) noon, prevailing time, on the third Thursday in February.”

Petitions may be obtained at the election commission office during regular office hours listed below. Any person interested in running for office should contact the Cumberland County Election Commission Office.

**WITHDRAWAL DEADLINE: FEBRUARY 27, 2014 AT 12:00 NOON**

A candidate's request to withdraw must be in writing and filed with each of the Counties where the candidate filed their nominating petition.

**WRITE-IN CANDIDATES DEADLINE: March 17, 2014 at 12:00 NOON**

**In order for write-in ballots to be counted, notice must be filed no later than 12:00 Noon, prevailing time, on the fiftieth (50) day before the election, in each county that makes up the district of the listed office.**

**LAST DAY TO REGISTER TO VOTE: APRIL 7, 2014**

**ABSENTEE BALLOT REQUESTS: FEBRUARY 5, 2014 – APRIL 29, 2014**

**EARLY VOTING : APRIL 16, 2014 – MAY 1, 2014**

**EARLY VOTING OFFICE HOURS: MONDAY – FRIDAY 8:00 TO 5:00, SATURDAYS 8:00 TO 12 NOON**

**NEW STATE LAW:** Federal or Tennessee state government issued photo ID is now required to vote, unless an exception applies. College student IDs will not be accepted. To learn more about the new law and its exceptions, contact the Election Commission Office.
