USDA issued guidance re-interpreting “state level” administrative expenses to include storage and distribution costs paid by SFAs to state contracted warehouses. Therefore, excess funds have been issued as rebates to SFAs. The amount of excess funds available for rebates will fluctuate each year and the rebate program may or may not occur in the future depending on funding levels.

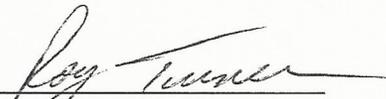
