July 18, 2022 Monthly Meeting Minutes

Be it remembered that the Cumberland County Commission met in monthly session on Monday, July 18, 2022 at the courthouse in Crossville, Tennessee. 7. RESOLUTION 07-2022-5 – TO APPROVE LEASE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CUMBERLAND COUNTY HOMESTEAD TOWER ASSOCIATION, INC. AND CUMBERLAND COUNTY:

On motion of Commissioner York, second by Commissioner Patterson moved to adopt resolution 07-2022-5.

The motion to adopt resolution 07-2022-5, approving the lease agreement between the Cumberland County Homestead Tower Association and Cumberland County with the term of the lease being for five (5) years, carried by a unanimous roll call vote from the commission present.

County Attorney Burnett gave a report of one (1) lawsuit being filed in the past 30 days. It is a proceed lawsuit which means there is no attorney on the plaintiff's side filed in Federal District Court. The case has odd allegations regarding the Sheriff's Department. 11. ADJOURNMENT:


