

WHEREAS, a Life Safety/Occupancy Inspection fee of \$250 needs to be added to the Schedule of Permit Fees; and

WHEREAS, the Cumberland County Codes Department has full authority to enforce and charge fees for such service and inspections.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Cumberland County Board of Commissioners hereby approves and adopts the attached Residential and Commercial Building Codes Schedule of Permit Fees for Cumberland County effective March 18, 2024 that includes the fee schedule for Life and Safety/Occupancy inspections of \$250. The Cumberland County Codes Department has the full authority to charge and enforce these fees and create applicable rules and regulations in the enforcement of codes and fees as allowed by law.
