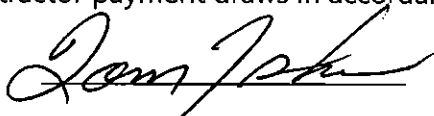
WHEREAS, Crawford & Company will provide construction oversight and review and approve the Contractor's work and payment draws; and

3. RESOLUTION 08-2026-1 – AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OF CUMBERLAND COUNTY TO SIGN A PROPOSAL WITH THE TENNESSEE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR STATE PROJECT NOS. 18S299-S1-004, 18S299-S3-005, AND 18S299-S2-005 (FOSTER):

Discussion: Commissioner Sherrill stated after some questioning he is certain there is no plan to close Pig Path Road in the Westel Community, Mayor Foster confirmed he has no knowledge of there being any closure plans to Pig Path Road, Commissioner Wilson reiterated that the only way a road in Cumberland County can be closed is by going through committee and then onto a full commission vote, a closure would have to be a unanimous vote.
